

EXHIBIT: ACP CITRUS-T TRANSPORTER / HAULER

PROVISIONS FOR THE INTRASTATE MOVEMENT OF BULK CITRUS FRUIT FROM OR WITHIN THE ASIAN CITRUS PSYLLID STATE INTERIOR QUARANTINE AREA

Establishment agrees to the following:

1. Establishments Under Compliance

- a. Only transport shipments from a Grower/Grove Manager operating under compliance with the ACP Program.
- b. Only transport shipments to a Packer/Juicer/Other Processor operating under compliance with the ACP Program.

2. Transporter Cleanliness

- a. All shipments of citrus fruit and pallets/field bins, regardless of origin or destination, must be loaded into a shipping container, conveyance or vehicle with solid walls, or shipment of citrus fruit and pallets/field bins must be completely covered with a tarp or mesh with holes no larger than approximately 0.3 square millimeters (0.547mm x 0.547mm or 0.6mm x 0.5mm) in size.
- b. The vehicle and/or trailer used for transporting the shipment must be free of all leaf and stem debris and free of all life stages of ACP prior to transport and after delivery.

3. Evidence of Compliance

Place a copy of the compliance agreement, this exhibit, and the applicable "ACP-Free Declaration" form in each transport vehicle.

4. Direct Route

Take the most continuous, direct route, without interruption to the approved receiver.

5. Green Waste Disposal

All green waste, including leaf and stem debris, must be disposed of in accordance with the ACP Program, local County Agricultural Commissioner, under QC Master Permit 1289 or other ACP Program approved manner.

6. Records

Maintain records of all ACP host shipments leaving the quarantine area and provide records to agriculture inspectors immediately upon request.

7. Training

Ensure all employees receive training to be compliant with all specifications of this compliance agreement exhibit.

8. Spill Notification

Notify the ACP Program as soon as possible and no later than 24 hours after spillage of any shipment.

9. Vehicle Tracking System

List all truck and trailer license plates on the second page of this exhibit. Update the ACP Program immediately any time license plates are added, change, or are no longer in use. If more space is needed, continue on back of this exhibit.
