I am pleased to submit the 1990 Agricultural Crop and Livestock Report for the acreage, production, and value of agricultural crops and products in Riverside County.

This year's Agricultural Crop and Livestock Report represents a total gross return of \$1,137,174,100. This is an increase of \$44,393,000 from the 1989 report. The gross value for agricultural crops was \$713,361,100, an increase of \$63,222,300 from the previous year. The value for livestock and poultry product production was \$423,813,000, a decrease of \$18,829,300 over the 1989 value.

It must be emphasized that this report reflects a gross return and in no way represents a measure of profit or loss to the producer. Leading agricultural economists agree that every dollar received by farmers in Riverside County in 1990 has the financial impact of three times that amount. Therefore, \$1,137,174,100 becomes over \$3.4 Billion revenue generated into the total economy.

The 1990 December freeze will long be remembered for its devastation of California's agriculture. Values shown in this report are largely unaffected by the freeze, however the 1991 report will certainly reflect the depth and breadth of this disaster to Riverside County.

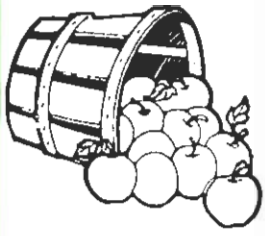

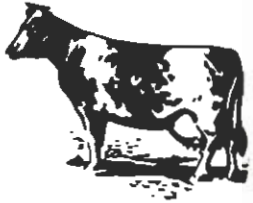
