TO: ALL RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMIT HOLDERS ALL OPERATOR IDENTIFICATION NUMBER HOLDERS

This year, the Agricultural Commissioner's Office will begin taking appointments to begin issuing permits and Operator I.D. Numbers as early as November 1, 2023. Please contact your local district office. (You may be subject to a headquarter inspection prior to the issuance of your permit)

As a reminder, please note the following:

- 1. Person(s) wishing to obtain a 2024 Restricted Materials Permit or an Operator I.D. Number must call their <u>local</u> Agricultural Commissioner's district office and arrange for an <u>appointment in advance</u> of coming into the office.*
- 2. Persons should plan on at least forty-five minutes in order to complete the Restricted Material Permitting process.
- 3. It is mandatory that persons bring with them all necessary materials to complete the process, including:
 - (a) complete, updated maps of each site (including locations of wellheads)
 - (b) crops, locations, acreages (or estimates of same)
 - (c) list of requested pesticides to be used
 - (d) Assessor parcel numbers (APN's) for each site

If a permittee has not filed Pesticide Use Reports or is delinquent in doing so, permits must be refused until that problem is resolved. If you are uncertain as to your Pesticide Use Report status, please contact one of our district offices immediately. *

PESTICIDE USE REPORTS MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY; FOR FURTHER INFORMATION PLEASE CONTACT ONE OF OUR DISTRICT OFFICES.
THE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE WILL NO LONGER MAILS COURTESY REMINDERS FOR PERMIT RENEWALS.
